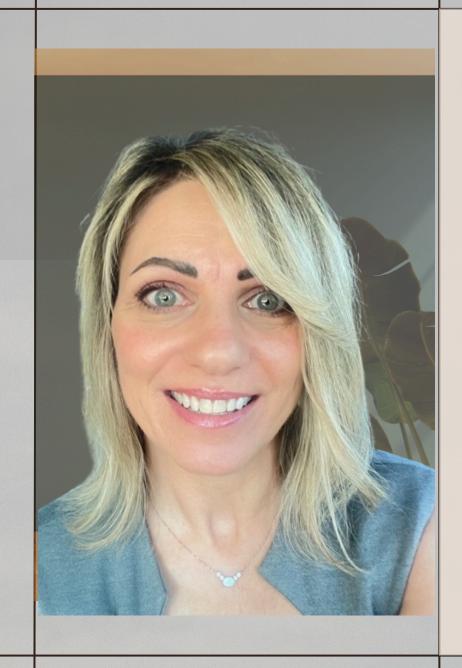

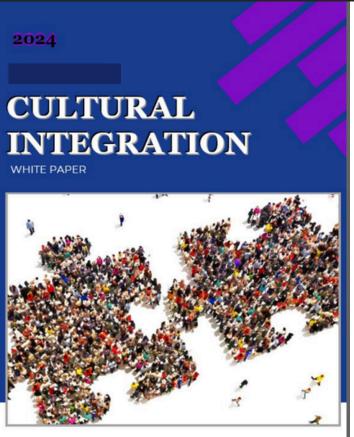
They call it a white paper, but it's the double-007 of white papers, the launchpad for a national training product and a seven-figure licensing deal.
